Dated: Manpower status of Beldars/dailywagers in HPPWI

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I am directed to convey that it has been observed by the Hon'ble Chief Minister that at present 25004 beldars is a huge force at the command of the department which should be fruitfully utilized for the maintenance of assets like roads, proper upkeep of government residential and office buildings etc. It seems that either this work force is not properly deployed or being used at places or positions other than intended or there is lack of supervision and control. The Hon'ble Chief Minister has directed to inter alia to consider the following action immediately.

1. Proper deployment of beldars for maintenance of assets by allotting given length of road or area to a gang of beldars, keeping proper record of such allotment of work to them and regular checking of progress by JES/AES/XENS.

To ensure that Gang huts are being used for the intended purpose.

Devising system of marking of attendance every day be each Beldar and ensuring their regularity, punctuality and presence on site for physical progress.

- Recording of work done by them in MB.
- 5. Whether beldars are entitled to uniform? If yes, the uniform code should be enforced strictly.

The Hon'ble Chief Minister has further desired the Department to draw a strategy to optimally utilize this work force and issue instructions to each division clearly spelling out the mechanism regarding the work to be assigned to beldars and how their performance shall be monitored and reported. This matter may kindly be reviewed and steps taken by department.
