Dear Sir,

The Padma Awards, namely, Padma Vibhushan, Padma Bhushan and Padma Shri, are amongst the highest civilian awards of the country. Instituted in 1954, these awards are announced on the occasion of the Republic Day every year. The award seeks to recognize 'work of distinction' and is given for distinguished and exceptional achievements/service in all fields/disciplines, such as, Art, Literature and Education, Sports, Medicine, Sociał Work, Science and Engineering, Public Affairs, Civil Service, Trade and Industry etc. All persons without distinction of race, occupation, position or sex are eligible for these awards. A copy of the statutes and rules relating to these awards is enclosed (Annex - I).

2. It is the conventional practice to invite nominations for these awards from all State/ UT Governments as also from several other sources to enable broad-based consideration.

3. It has been decided with approval of competent authority that from this year the nominations/recommendations for the Padma Awards will be received online only, on an electronic management system designed by MHA. (address of the website: <u>www.padmaawards.gov.in.</u>) The nominations/recommendations should contain all relevant details specified in the format available on the above said website, including a citation in narrative form (maximum 800 words), clearly bringing out the distinguished and exceptional achievements/service of the person recommended in his/ her respective field/discipline. While recommending a person online please make sure that all the necessary details are filled properly. Details relating to the steps to be taken for making online recommendations are enclosed for guidance.

4. It has been observed in the past that while nominations are received in respect of a plarge number of persons, there could, however, be several talented persons who are left out of consideration despite exceptional contribution in their field. Often many of these persons may get overlooked primarily for the reason that they may not seek publicity or attention in the public domain. It is, therefore, requested you to make concerted efforts in identifying such persons whose excellence and achievements really deserve to be recognized, and make suitable nominations in their favour. It goes without saying that recognition of such deserving persons will only add to the lustre of these awards.

5. In the above background, I am to request you to kindly send suitable nominations for the Padma awards to be announced on the occasion of Republic Day, 2017. In this regard, it is suggested that you may constitute a special Search Committee for identifying, considering and finalizing your recommendations/ nominations. Further, while finalizing the recommendations, the following points may be kept in view:-

(i) Persons recommended are pre-eminently worthy of the awards, looking at their lifetime achievement. The criteria for selection should invariably be 'excellence plus' and the highest standards should be applied while recommending persons for these awards. The existence of an element of public service in the achievements of the person recommended for the award would be a desirable factor.

As the Padma award is the second highest award of the country, it should be considered whether the recommended person has earlier been given any National (ii)

award or at least a State award in his respective field. Efforts may be made to identify talented persons from amongst women, weaker sections of the society, SCs & STs, handicapped persons, etc., who deserve to be (iii)

The decoration is normally not conferred posthumously. However, in highly deserving cases, Government could consider giving an award posthumously if the demise of the person proposed to be honoured has been recent, say within a period (iv) of one year preceding the Republic Day on which it is proposed to announce the

- A higher category of Padma award can be considered in respect of a person who has earlier been conferred an award, provided a period of at least five years has elapsed. However, in exceptionally deserving cases, a relaxation can be (v)
- Government servants including those working with PSUs, except Doctors and Scientists, are not eligible for Padma Awards. (vi)

The online nominations/recommendations for the Padma Awards will begin from May 1, 2016 and the last date for nominations for Padma Awards is September The cut-off date may please be strictly adhered to, as nominations/recommendations received only during 1st May, 2016 to 15th September, also be noted that the nominations/recommendations received through online mode only will be considered.

The geometrical pattern shall be composed of the outer lines of a square of one and three-sixteenths inches side, centrally placed on each side of which shall be a rectangle projecting beyond the rim thereby breaking the circumference of the circular design of the decoration. The decoration shall be worn by nexa on the left breast, suspended from a lotus pink riband one and a quarter inches in width with two narrow white stripes each a quarter inch distant from the edges of the riband; and by women on the left shoulder, suspended from a riband of the same collar and width fashioned into a bow.

- Process for sending nominations/recommendations by the Citizens of India and by the specified Authorities has to be followed in all cases . The details are available on the above said website.
 - For Nomination (By citizen) process, please follow the given steps:
 - 1. Go to Nomination and chose BY CITIZEN option.
 - 2. Now register yourself with valid details for further process.

 - 3. If you have already registered, proceed to login. 4. After successful registration and login process, follow the user-menu to nominate
 - 5. Upload the relevant documents (in PDF format) wherever required.

 - 6. After filling all the required details, you have to save the form as draft. 7. In nomination process, after Final Submission you cannot edit/modify the details.
