Regarding not allowing the Contractors to participating in NABARD work who have not completed of NABARD Projects of RIDF-XXV to RIDF XXVIII & PMGSY-I & II Projects

As you are well aware that 35 Nos. Projects under RIDF-XXX(NABARD) have been sanctioned in the year 2024-25 and the tender process of these projects is underway in the Department. It has been observed that most of the Contractors have not completed Projects of RIDF XXV to RIDF XXVIII & PMGSY-I & II Projects and they may also participate in NABARD Projects sanctioned under RIDF XXX.

The matter has been considered and it has been observed that for the sake of efficiency of the projects, it is necessary to add the specific condition in the SBD (Standard Bidding Document) for NABARD to complete the works timely. Therefore, it has been decided that the *Contractors who have not completed the projects of RIDF-XXV to RIDF XXVIII & PMGSY-I & II Projects till date due to their poor performance, negligence or fault will be disqualified straight way subject to the condition of performance certificate to be issued by the concerned Executive Engineer's concerned countersigned by Superintending Engineer concerned (Appendix to ITB 4.7) shall be incorporated accordingly.*

You are, therefore, requested to look into the matter personally and direct all the field units working under your control not to allow the defaulting Contractors who has not completed the work of RIDF XXV to RIDF XXVIII & PMGSY-I & II Projects to participate in the NABARD Projects sanctioned under RIDF XXX to avoid un-necessary litigation in later stage.
