In continuation to this department letter of even number dated 06.04.2018 (which is available alongwith earlier references on the Vigilance link of Home Department in the official website of State Government) on the subject cited above, I am directed to inform that the CWPIL No.111/2017 titled Caurt on its own motion Vs State of HP & others was listed before the Hon'ble High Court again on 26.04.2018, 09.05.2018 &10.05.2017 and the Hon'ble Court has taken a serious view in delay of departmental enquires/proceedings against officers/ officials involved Vigilance/Criminal/Deportmental cases. Whereas the departmental enquiries in wherein the Officer(s) is/are involved in Vigilance cases must be completed within 3 months from the date of 1st hearing taken by the Inquiry Officer as per decision of the State Government.

However, the Hon'ble Court has also directed the respondent State to ensure the completion of all departmental proceedings in a time bound manner and the Inquiry Officers who have been entrusted enquiries be instructed to conclude the all pending departmental enquiries including those where the officers/officials are simultaneously involved in Vigilance cases by

conducting departmental proceedings on day to day basis in accordance with Law.

You are, therefore, requested to take further necessary action in this regard accordingly in compliance to the directions of the Honble High Court.
