Subject: - CWP NO.8685/2011-Titled as Sh. Nand Lal Vs. State of H.P. & ors.

The subject cited case was listed before the Hon'ble High Court on 17.12.2015 whenafter hearing the matter the Hon'ble High Court has been pleased to dispose of the same with the directions as under:-

"Writ petitioner has invoked the jurisdiction of this Court by the medium of this writ petition and has sought writ of mandamus commanding the respondent not to grant permits for plying multi/Axle trucks and in the alternative, for improving the conditions of the roads in the State of Himachal Pradesh, on the grounds taken in the writ petition.

2. The writ petition, on the face of it, is not maintainable and the same is dismissed as such alongwith all pending applications. However, we hope and trust that the respondents will take all possible measures to improve the conditions of the roads in the State.

The perusal of above order reveals that the Hon'ble High Court though has been pleased to dismiss the writ petition being not maintainable. However the Hon'ble High Court has also directed respondent public works department to take all possible measures to improve the condition of the roads in the State.

You are, therefore, requested to please ensure to comply with the directions passed by the Hon'ble High Court in letter and spirit by taking all possible measures to improve the condition of roads falling under your respective jurisdiction.
