Dear Chief Secretary / Administrator

As you may be aware, Constitution Day is celebrated every year on 26th November to commemorate the adoption of the Constitution of India and to pay tribute to the invaluable contribution of Babasaheb Dr. Bhimrao Ambedkar and other founding fathers of the Constitution.

2. This year the country is celebrating 70th anniversary of the adoption of the Constitution. To commemorate this very important event in the life of Indian democracy, Government of India proposes to launch a National Campaign focusing on creating awareness regarding a very important feature of the Constitution - the Fundamental Duties. This campaign would start on the 26th November 2019 and culminate on 14th April 2020, Babasaheb Ambedkar's Birth Anniversary which is celebrated as "Samrasta Diwas". By reaffirming our commitment to the Fundamental Duties, it is felt that all citizens can play a positive and effective role in fulfilling our duties towards our country and fellow citizens.

3. Ministry of Law and Justice, Govt. of India as the Nodal Ministry will work with other ministries/departments of the Government of India, State Governments and Public & Private Organisations in this National Campaign.

4. I am enclosing a list of activities that may be undertaken by various departments and organisations of the state government in the campaign. As part of the campaign, educational institutions including schools, colleges, engineering and medical colleges, law schools/law faculties may organise essay, debate, talks and quiz competitions. Seminars and talks by eminent citizens on Fundamental Duties may also be organised as part of the campaign through state Education Departments, State Legal Services Authority/District Legal Services Authorities etc. Educational Institutions government offices and private organisations may hold assemblies where the participants will be administered a Pledge on Fundamental Duties. In addition Gram Panchayats and Urban Local

Bodies may organise special meetings as part of the campaign. Intensive publicity and public outreach will be organised through various media including social media to spread the message of Fundamental Duties. The campaign will start from 26th November 2019 through a prominent State Level function, and it would culminate on 14th April 2020.

5. I request that necessary preparations in close coordination with the Department of Justice, Govt. of India may be initiated immediately so that the Campaign can be rolled out in an effective and timely manner.

6. I am confident that with your active participation, we would be able to spread awareness about Fundamental Duties throughout the country and sensitise the citizens regarding the exalted values and precepts enshrined in the Constitution.

¹[PART IVA FUNDAMENTAL DUTIES

51A. It shall be the duty of every citizen of India—

Fundamental
duties.

(a) to abide by the Constitution and respect its ideals and institutions, the National Flag and the National Anthem;

(b) to cherish and follow the noble ideals which inspired our national struggle for freedom;

(c) to uphold and protect the sovereignty, unity and integrity of India;

(d) to defend the country and render national service when called upon to do so;

(e) to promote harmony and the spirit of common brotherhood amongst all the people of India transcending religious, linguistic and regional or sectional diversities; to renounce practices derogatory to the dignity of women;

(f) to value and preserve the rich heritage of our composite culture;

(g) to protect and improve the natural environment including forests, lakes, rivers and wild life, and to have compassion for living creatures;

(h) to develop the scientific temper, humanism and the spirit of inquiry and reform;

(i) to safeguard public property and to abjure violence;

(j) to strive towards excellence in all spheres of individual and collective activity so that the nation constantly rises to higher levels of endeavour and achievement;

*[(k) who is a parent or guardian to provide opportunities for education to his child or, as the case may be, ward between the age of six and fourteen years.]

THE CONSTITUTION OF INDIA

WE, THE PEOPLE OF INDIA, having solemnly resolved to constitute India into a ¹[SOVEREIGN SOCIALIST SECULAR DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC] and to secure to all its citizens:

Preamble.

JUSTICE, social, economic and political;

LIBERTY of thought, expression, belief, faith and worship;

EQUALITY of status and of opportunity;

and to promote among them all

FRATERNITY assuring the dignity of the individual and the ²[unity and integrity of the Nation];

IN OUR CONSTITUENT ASSEMBLY this twenty-sixth day of November, 1949, do HEREBY ADOPT, ENACT AND GIVE TO OURSELVES THIS CONSTITUTION.
