





I would like to invite your kind attention to this Department letter No. SJE-B-A(4)-16/2018 dated 25-08-2018 regarding implementation of Section 24(1) and Section 37 of Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 (copy enclosed).

The two Sections provides for 25% higher quantum of assistance of all programme and schemes for the Persons with Disabilities and 5% reservation in allotment of Agriculture land, Housing development and poverty alleviation programme etc respectively.

Despite various meetings and communication we have not been given any feedback on action taken. Since Government of India and the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India are monitoring the implementation of RPwDs Act, 2016. It is requested that necessary action in the matter may be taken immediately so as to ensure implementation of the Act in its proper prospective in the State. A letter in compliance of ATN may please be given.

notification required to be issued thereof.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to the subject cited above and to
say that the RPwD, Act, 2016 under section 24 (1) & 37 provides as
under:-

Section 24 (1) of RPwD Act, 2016

The appropriate Government shall within
the limit of its economic capacity and development
formulate necessary schemes and programmes to
safeguard and promote the right of persons with
disabilities for adequate standard of living to enable
them to live independently or in the community:

Provided that the quantum of assistance to
the persons with disabilities under such schemes
and programmes shall be at least twenty-five
percent higher than the similar schemes applicable
to others.

Section 37 of RPwD Act, 2016

The appropriate Government and the local
authorities shall, by notification, make schemes in
favour of persons with benchmark disabilities, to
provide:-

- (a) Five per cent reservation in allotment of
agricultural land and housing in all relevant

schemes and development programmes, with appropriate priority to women with benchmark disabilities;

(b) Five percent reservation in all poverty alleviation and various developmental schemes with priority to women with benchmark disabilities.

(c) Five per cent reservation in allotment of land on concessional rate, where such land is to be used for the purpose of promoting housing, shelter, setting up to occupation, business, enterprise, recreation centres and production centres.

In view of the above, it is requested that under the sections re-produced above action may be taken if anything pertains to your Department under these sections.
