Policy/quidelines for naming /renaming of Roads and installation of Statue/memorials on the Martyrs/Shaheed.

- Secretary(PW), Engineer-in-Chief, HPPWD, Chief Engineer(SZ) & Superintending Engineer(Works) shall decide on naming /renaming of roads and installation of permanent Gates/statues/memorials. This authority shall do scrutiny and processing of the proposals for naming alteration of existing name and sending the new proposal to the Govt. for final approval.
- 2 The Jurisdiction of the Authority extends to all roads owned by HPPWD.

3 Naming of roads

- (i) Request for naming a road should come from a group of persons such as Association, Manch, Sangh, Group etc. and not from a single person. The entity should normally be registered under the Societies Registration Act.
- (ii) The proposal shall come from the concerned D.C. with his recommendation for consideration by naming authority at State level.
- (iii) Every proposal should be accompanied by a brief write up about the accomplishments of the individual whose name is proposed.
- (iv) If any road/Park/street//Building etc. has already been named after a particular dignitary, then a fresh proposal for naming any other place after the same dignitary will normally be not entertained.

- (v) The services rendered by the nominee to the nation and particularly to Himachal Pradesh will be the major guiding principle for taking a decision.
- (vi) A road should be named as far as possible in the area where particular dignitary resided.
- (vii) Name of living persons will not be entertained.
- (viii) While considering names of foreigners (of International standing) the views of Ministry of External Affairs shall be obtained.

4 Renaming of Roads

- (i) The names of existing roads shall normally not be changed . Only new roads will be considered for being named after eminent personalities.
- (ii) Names which are a part of history will normally not be altered.
- (iii) All proposals for renaming will be referred to Administrative Department to Public Works.

5. Installation of statues/memorials/Gates

The following eight conditions are required to be fulfilled before a request is considered by state road name authority.

- i) Cost of the work relating to the statue, including cost of fabrication, transportation and installation should be borne by the organization.
- ii) The organization shall obtain clearance of Art, culture & language Department regarding size/metal/design of statues.

- iii) It will be the responsibility of the organization to have proper landscaping of the area in consultation with the local authorities i.e. PWD/MC/NAC.
- iv) The sponsoring organization shall bear the cost of maintenance of the statue and its surroundings.
- v) The statue shall be installed in accordance with the site plan to be obtained by the organization from the PWD/MC/NAC.
- vi) As regards, the site for the statues, traffic roundabouts shall normally not be considered.
- vii) Normally sanction for installation of second statue will not be considered. However, if the first statue installed is not easily accessible or prominently visible to the general public, a proposal for installation of a second statue may be considered.
- viii) Every proposal for erecting any kind of statue on HPPWD road will be accompanied by an NOC form the concerned Executive Engineer/ Land owing agency.
- 6. All proposal will be examined at District level committee comprising of Deputy Commissioner, Sub-Divisional Magistrate and concerned Executive Engineer of the HPPWD and thereafter at State Level, Secretary(PW), Engineer-in-Chief, HPPWD and Superintending Engineer(Works), will process the proposal and will get the approval from the competent Authority/Minister –in -Charge.
